Virtual Urgent Care *powered by KeyCare*

Access a provider from your home, office or on-the-go, 24/7, 365. Board-certified providers can visit with you by secure video to help treat non-emergency medical conditions. Visits are free for most members.** **Go to ghccareondemand.com/keycare.**



Virtual Therapy *powered by MDLIVE[®]*

Access a therapist from your home, office or on-the-go, 24/7, 365. Licensed therapists and board-certified psychiatrists visit with you either by phone or secure video to help treat any non-emergency mental health condition. Visits are free for most members.** **Go to ghccareondemand.com/mdlive.**

* For GHCMYChartSM Video Visits, members must be physically located within the state of Wisconsin during the entirety of the visit.

GHC-SCW Urgent Care

Urgent care is for non-life-threatening conditions that need to be treated that same day or after business hours. These conditions usually cause unusual discomfort.

Examples include:

- back pain
- ear pain
- colds and flu
- cuts, scrapes or bruises
- eye irritation
- fever
- migraine headaches
- sore throats
- simple bone fractures (not through skin)
- sprains
- skin rashes
- urinary burning

Physical therapy is available for some injuries at the GHC-SCW Urgent Care Clinic.

Call the GHC-SCW Urgent Care Clinic to schedule an appointment. **Appointments are required for Urgent Care and are made to better serve your same-day access needs. Walk-in appointments are not available.**

Emergency Care

Emergency care is for life-threatening medical conditions (including severe symptoms) that can cause serious danger to your health.

Examples include:

- alcohol or drug overdose
- amputations or severe lacerations
- complex bone fractures (through skin)
- complications during pregnancy¹
- facial or eye trauma
- heart attack or chest pain
- knife or gunshot wounds
- loss of consciousness
- poisoning
- respiratory problems
- severe burns
- stroke

If it's not possible to go to your designated hospital, go to the nearest hospital emergency room or call 911.
